<b>Exclusions</b>	Documentation of medical reason for exclusion (e.g. specimen originated from other malignant neoplasms, secondary site prostatic carcinomas, and transurethral resections of the prostate (TURP)
<b>Exclusion details</b>	Documentation of medical reason for exclusion (e.g. specimen originated from other malignant neoplasms, secondary site prostatic carcinomas, or transurethral resections of the prostate (TURP) [For patient with appropriate exclusion criteria, report 3267F with modifier 1P.]
<b>Risk Adjustment</b>	No risk adjustment or risk stratification
